CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO  
KEITH CYRUS  
STAR RT  
SISTERS, OR 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of KEITH CYRUS RESERVOIR constructed under Permit R-4807, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 53.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-31702. The date of priority is DECEMBER 13, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 68.0 ACRE-FEET of stored water.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to describe changes in type of use approved by an order of the Director entered on December 29, 1997, and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, Page 1408 approving a petition by Squaw Creek Irrigation District under ORS 541.325 to 541.333 for mapping water rights within a district and supersedes Certificate 44279, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
