confirms the right to use the waters of the Ford Branch of the Little Walla Walla River, a tributary of the Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for FROST PROTECTION on 8.7 ACRES

This right was perfected under Permit S-39034. The priority date is 4/15/1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.531 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:


This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the location of the point of diversion, described on Certificate 92829. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 92829, and describes the water rights NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2017, and recorded in Special Order Volume 104, Page 547, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 92829.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
