 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the South Branch Mud Creek Basin, tributary of the Walla Walla River for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 0.2 ACRES and FROST PROTECTION.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10441. The priority dates are 03/23/1984 for 0.01 cubic foot per second (cfs) and & 04/16/1984 for 0.01 cfs. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.020 cubic feet per second (cfs), being 0.003 cfs for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION and 0.017 cfs for FROST PROTECTION, or their equivalents in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cfs per acre for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the priority dates described on Certificate 92876. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 92876, and describes the water rights NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2017, and recorded in Special Order Volume 104, Page 547, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 92876.
