CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, tributary of the Walla Walla River for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 0.35 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-974. The priority date is 6/17/1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the place of use described on Certificate 92893. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 92893, and describes the water rights NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2017, and recorded in Special Order Volume 104, Page 547, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 92893.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
