CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-3743. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: APLEGATE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE ROGUE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 14.7 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.184 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 25, 1918

The point of diversion is located as follows:

38 S	4 W	WM	22	SW NE	38	720 FEET SOUTH AND 1800 FEET WEST FROM MOST EASTERLY NE CORNER, DLC 38

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 19, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 344, approving Transfer Application 6515, and together with Certificate 66551, supercedes Certificate 65145, State record of Water Right Certificates.
