The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

This certificate is issued to describe the portion remaining following the issuance of Special Order Volume 50, Page 615, on September 19, 1996, cancelling a portion of Certificate 66551, and supersedes Certificate 66551, State record of Water Right Certificates.
