confirms the right to the use of waters of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for IRRIGATION.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498. The dates of priority are 1875 for Tract 1 and 1908 for Tract 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.163 cubic foot per second (CFS) for Tract 1 and 0.266 CFS for Tract 2, measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The water user shall maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted as required by the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 31, 2008, at Special Order Volume 76, Page 648, approving Transfer Application T-10305, and together with Certificate 84353, supercedes Certificate 17221, State record of Water Right Certificates.
