### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

# STATE OF OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK HOOD RIVER, tributary to HOOD RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-165. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 13, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.5 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from June 30 through September 30.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 39048, located approximately at approximately RM 6.2:

To the mouth of the West Fork of Hood River at River Mile 0.0 at the confluence with Hood River.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. Stream channel losses and gains calculated based on available data and the use of water by senior appropriators will determine the amount of water to which this right is entitled downstream from the original point of diversion within the specified stream reach.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 39048, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER finalized by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume , Page , approving Conserved Water Application CW-76, and together with Certificate 94053, supersedes Certificate 39048, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
