CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R. I. STUART
MEDFORD, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of NEIL CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 14.77 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 5.23 ACRES.

That said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at Page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1873.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.18 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.07 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:


This certificate is issued to describe the right modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 30, 2019, and recorded at Special Order Volume 112, Page 305, approving a partial diminution of the right evidenced by Certificate 15980, State Record of Water Right Certificates. This certificate supersedes Certificate 15980.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
