This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 57. The date of priority is 1892.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 ACRE FOOT PER ACRE DURING ANY PERIOD OF 30 DAYS OR 3.0 ACRE FEET PER ACRE DURING ANY IRRIGATION SEASON.
