CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-3859. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: GOOSE CREEK, WEST EAGLE CREEK, TRAVERSE LAKE RESERVOIR AND ECHO LAKE RESERVOIR, RESERVOIRS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-436, FOR TRACT 1 AND WEST EAGLE CREEK AND GOOSE CREEK FOR TRACT 3, TRIBUTARIES OF POWDER RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 45.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 5.5 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.56 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM DIRECT FLOW AND 7.28 ACRE-FEET FROM ECHO LAKE RESERVOIR AND 4.13 ACRE-FEET FROM TRAVERSE LAKE RESERVOIR

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 18, 1917

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated under each tract from direct flow, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


