CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-3939. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: EAGLE LAKE RESERVOIR AND LOOKING GLASS RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMITS R-440 AND R-441

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 45.5 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 33.26 ACRE-FEET, OR ITS EQUIVALENT IN CASE OF ROTATION, MEASURED AT THE POINT OF DIVERSION FROM THE RESERVOIRS

DATES OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 18, 1917 FOR LOOKING GLASS RESERVOIR AND NOVEMBER 16, 1917, FOR EAGLE LAKE RESERVOIR

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Location is in reference to the Willamette Meridian.

The right shall be exercised by means of exchange for the waters of West Eagle Creek in accordance with an order of Charles E. Stricklin, dated December 21, 1943, in the matter of the application of Orin Hutton, et al, for a change of use of water. The waters of West Eagle Creek may be diverted through what was formerly known as the Hogum Ditch, now known as the Phillips-Ingle Ditch. The point of diversion for the Phillips-Ingle Ditch on West eagle Creek is located:


SE¼ SE¼, Section 8, Township 6 South, Range 43 East, W.M., Baker County

If at any time during the irrigation season, demand is made of the water of Eagle Creek below the confluence of West Eagle Creek with Eagle Creek, for a water right senior in time against the water rights for West Eagle Creek held by the owners of this water right, the watermaster shall cause to be released an amount into Eagle Creek from said lakes, an amount not to exceed that being diverted from West Eagle Creek by the owners of this water right, so that the quantity of water available would be the same as if no diversion was made by the owners of this water right of the natural flow of water of West Eagle Creek. If at the time of demand on the waters of Eagle Creek, no impounded water is available in said lakes, the watermaster shall turn down the waters of West Eagle Creek an amount necessary to satisfy Eagle Creek water rights below said confluence.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes aforesaid is restricted to beneficial use on the lands and place of use described, under and pursuant to the conditions above set forth for the exchange of natural flow water diverted from West Eagle Creek, for stored water released from said Eagle and Looking Glass lakes.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 387, approving Transfer Application T-11674, and together with Certificate 89250, supercedes Certificate 74008, State record of Water Right Certificates.
