 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WEST EXTENSION IRRIGATION DISTRICT

confirms the right to use the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 979.6 ACRES and 5.3 INCHOATE ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-45999. The date of priority is JUNE 15, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 24.61 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
