CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, tributary to the WALLA WALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION on 34.52 acres.

This right was perfected under by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority dates are 1878, 1886, 1888, 1893, 1893, 1896, 1898, 1903, and 1908.

The use is limited to 0.90 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), being ONE MINER'S INCH for all lands located with Section 36 and the NWSE of Section 35 (0.64 cfs), and ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE all other lands located within Section 35 (0.26 cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**



Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
