CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 5.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority date is 1886.

The use is limited to 1.0 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.125 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

5 N	35 E	WM	12	SW NE	1030 FEET NORTH AND 900 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 12

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes the portion of Certificate 92473, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 20 2018, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-28. This Certificate together with Certificate 94141, and a portion of the Applicant's portion of Conserved Water under CW-28, supersedes Certificate 92473.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
