## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WOLFE HEREFORD RANCH, WTK, INC. ATTN: STEPHEN WOLFE 81544 HWY 82 WALLOWA, OR 97885

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER (aka SOUTH FORK WALLOWA RIVER), a tributary to the WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.9 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5 at Page 200-202. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season, if available at the point of diversions, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water at the point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate describes that portion of Certificate 93533, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT MODIFIED by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered <u>DEC 2 8 2018</u>, approving Transfer Application T-12853, and corrects a scrivener's error in the priority date.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
