CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449.

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 196.1 ACRES, LIVESTOCK, DOMESTIC USE, AND POND MAINTENANCE IN A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-86674

MAXIMUM RATE: 2.81 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION OF 196.1 ACRES, LIVESTOCK, DOMESTIC USE, AND POND MAINTENANCE

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion (POD 3) for 3.4 acres located in the SW ¼ NE ¼ of Section 23, T. 14S, R. 14E, W.M., together with that diverted at the original point of diversion (POD 4), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 4).

The annual volume of water for pond maintenance shall not exceed 116.0 acre-feet, diverted during the irrigation season of each year.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screens and/or by-pass devices, as appropriate, at the new points of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device(s) for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device(s) must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate or headgates to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate(s) must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in CHARACTER OF USE, PLACE OF USE, POINTS OF DIVERSION, AND PARTIAL CANCELLATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 7, 2008, at Special Order Volume 74, Page 811, approving Transfer Application T-10233, and together with Certificate 83857, supercedes Certificate 81601, State record of Water Right Certificates.
