CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RUSSELL YOUNG

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 3.3 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 41360. The date of priority is JUNE 2, 1970.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
13 S	27 E	WM	12	SW NW	30 FEET NORTH AND 1060 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

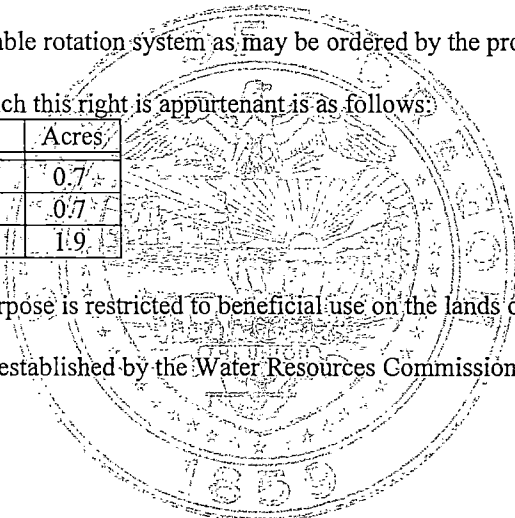
The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Acres
13 S	27 E	WM	12	NE SW	0.7
13 S	27 E	WM	12	SE SW	0.7
13 S	27 E	WM	12	SW SE	1.9

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.



**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 15, 2004, at Special Order Volume 59, Page 116, approving Transfer Application 9551, supersedes Certificate 57837, State record of Water Right Certificates.
