## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RUSSELL YOUNG PO BOX 171 CANYON CITY OR 97825

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 54.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15 at Page 461. The date of priority is March 14, 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.36 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30, and shall be further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; for a diversion not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
