The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation (UMAT 43/UMAT 45-extended casing). The new well shall be cased and sealed to a minimum depth of 225 feet below land surface.

The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at the new point of appropriation. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 11, 2011, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 360, approving Transfer Application T-10937, and supercedes Certificate 75563, State record of Water Right Certificates.
