for the purpose of Irrigation of 167.4 acres & stock water for Tract No. 1; Irrigation of 61.5 acres, and stock water for Tract No.2.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume

10

, at page

227

; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876 for Tract No. 1, and January 27,1908 for Tract No. 2.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforcsaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated prior to June 15th, and one-eightieth of a cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated after June 15th, of each year, with a total limitation during each irrigation season of three acre feet per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appartenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
