CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DANIEL R. PELISSIER  
8141 UPPER APPLGATE RD  
JACKSONVILLE OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.99 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1908.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

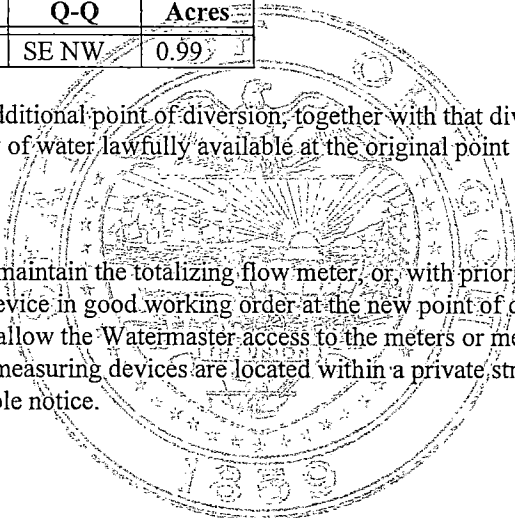
A description of the place of use is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Acres
39 S	3 W	WM	33	SE NW	0.99

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device in good working order at the new point of diversion.
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.



**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 29, 2017, at Special Order Volume 107, Page 345, approving Transfer Application 12622 as further modified by a correcting order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 2018, at Special Order Volume 112, Page 72, and together with Certificate 94165, supercedes Certificate 32829, State record of Water Right Certificates.
