CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HENRY KERBY
RT 1 BOX 465
ASHLAND, OR 97520

confirms the right to the use of DRAINAGE AND SEEPAGE WATER FROM WEST, MIDDLE AND EAST DRAWS IN NEIL CREEK WATERSHED, a tributary of BEAR CREEK for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 2.77 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-14857. The date of priority is APRIL 8, 1941. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.02 CFS FROM WEST DRAW, 0.01 CFS FROM MIDDLE DRAW AND 0.008 CFS FROM EAST DRAW or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 14336, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 30 2019, approving Transfer Application T-12448.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
