confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-4700. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WATER BEARING GRAVEL STRATA, A TRIBUTARY OF INDIAN CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION ON 8.65 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 19, 1920

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use as described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.

This certificate is issued to correct errors in Certificate 93377. Certificate 93377 was issued to describe the right NOT modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered October 30, 2017, and recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Pages 46-56, approving a partial cancellation. It was issued to supersede Certificate 76361; however, Certificate 76361 had been previously cancelled and superseded by Certificate 93375. Certificate 93375 was issued to confirm place of use changes under T-12254 as confirmed in Special Order Volume 105, Page 1003-1007. This certificate supersedes both Certificate 93375 and Certificate 93377.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
