CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of POND "A", a tributary of COLD SPRINGS RESERVOIR for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 38.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-30267.

The date of priority is DECEMBER 9, 1964.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.96 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The Point of Diversion is located:

4 N	29 E	WM	11	SE NE	1340 FEET SOUTH AND 1060 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 11

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate confirms a change in place of use approved by the provisions of an Order of the Water Resources Director entered November 7, 2017, Special Order Volume 107 Page 150, approving Transfer Application T-11693, and that portion of the right NOT modified by the order, and supersedes Certificate 74657.
