CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK ROGUE RIVER, a tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50242. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 25, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

32 S	3 E	WM	29	NW SW	590 FEET SOUTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 88740, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 01 2019, approving Transfer Application T-12754.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
