 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Walla Walla River, a tributary of Columbia River, for IRRIGATION of 5.26 ACRES.

This right was confirmed in part by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 12 at Page 9. The dates of priority are 1908 and 1879.

The use on these acres is limited to ONE MINER'S INCH per acre, or 0.132 cfs, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. This portion of the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The point of diversion is located as follows:


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
