This right was perfected under Permit S-1299. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.56 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), or its equivalent, in case of rotation.
