 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SAM JR. & DONNA LEFORE

confirms the right to use the waters of Walla Walla River, a tributary of Columbia River, for IRRIGATION of 20.5 ACRES and IRRIGATION AND STOCK USE on 4.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed, in part, by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 12 at Page 9. The dates of priority are 1875, 1879, 1889 and 1901. The use is limited to ONE MINER'S INCH per acre, or 0.612 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which the irrigation portion of this right is appurtenant is as follows:
