CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MCINTOSH TRUST HAZEL L. MCINTOSH, TRUSTEE 6940 HOLLAND LOOP RD CAVE JUNCTION OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF THE ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 51.95 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 253 and Volume 5, at Page 398. The date of priority is 1872 for Tract #1 and 1908 for Tract #2.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.96 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.72 cfs for 36.0 acres and 0.12 cfs for 6.0 acres in Tract #1, and 0.12 cfs for 9.95 acres in Tract #2; and that the use for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1st to October 31st of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 7, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 778, approving Transfer Application 8917, and together with Certificate 79569, supercedes Certificate 7140, State record of Water Right Certificates.
