 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of one well in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 11.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5024. The date of priority is MAY 29, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
