confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-11066. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: FIVE WELLS IN SANDY RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: NURSERY OPERATIONS ON 69.65 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.24 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.31 CFS FROM WELL 1, 0.93 CFS FROM WELL 2, 0.17 CFS FROM BENNET WELL 4, 0.56 CFS FROM POND WELL 5, AND 0.33 CFS FROM NEW WELL 6, NOT TO EXCEED A CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF 1.24 CFS IN ANY COMBINATION FROM THE FIVE WELLS

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 7, 1989

The amount of water used for NURSERY OPERATIONS is limited to a diversion of 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre. For the irrigation of **containerized nursery plants**, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre feet per acre per year. For the irrigation of **in ground nursery plants** the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre per year. The use of water for NURSERY OPERATIONS may be made at anytime of the year that the use is beneficial. For the irrigation of **any other crop**, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior surface and ground water rights of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.

The Director may require water levels or pump test results every ten years.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 21, 2016, at Special Order Volume 103, Page 246, approving Transfer Application 12118, supersedes Certificate 67130, State record of Water Right Certificates.
