CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit U-330. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: U-355

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL, in the THOMAS CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION of 5.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 22, 1950

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of **ONE-EIGHTIETH** of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at the new point of appropriation. If the Director notifies the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device.

This certificate confirms an order of the Director entered on JUNE 17, 2010, and recorded in Special Order Volume 81, Page 170, approving Transfer application T-9986. This certificate, together with Certificates 94311 and 86362, supersedes Certificate 22861.
