CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. T. WHARTON
MILTON-FREEWATER, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL for IRRIGATION of 0.94 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit U-164. The date of priority is MAY 29, 1945. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 15553, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 1, 2019, approving Transfer Application T-12787.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
