#### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

MERTON SAHNOW RT 1 BOX 45 CORNELIUS OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of the EAST DAIRY CREEK, tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 25.9 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 8.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-21026. The date of priority is DECEMBER 21, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.44 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to describe the right modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered APR 0 4 2019, and recorded in Special Order Volume 112, Pages 572-883, approving the partial diminution of the right evidenced by Certificate 23578. This certificate supersedes Certificate 23578.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.




