 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 32.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is OCTOBER, 1898.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.183 cubic foot per second; further limited to a maximum rate of 1/179 cubic foot per second per acre.

The point of diversion (hydraulically connected well) is located as follows:

Commencing at the SW corner of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 7; thence North 14 rods; thence East 22-6/7 rods; thence South 14 rods; thence West 22-6/7 rods to the place of beginning, being within Jackson County.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION FROM SURFACE WATER TO GROUND WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 18, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 738, approving Transfer Application 9726 and CW-36, and together with Certificates 82892, 82901, and 94326, supercedes Certificate 32818, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.
