confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-25991. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: CROOKED RIVER AND PRINEVILLE RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2223, TRIBUTARIES OF THE DESCHUTES RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 14.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 65.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.99 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION AT BOWMAN DAM AND PEOPLE'S DITCH DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING LOCATED WITHIN THE NW1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.; 1920 FEET NORTH AND 340 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 8), OR ITS EQUIVALENT IN CASE OF ROTATION, MEASURED AT THE POINT OF DIVERSION

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 8, 1914

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. The use of stored water under this right is subject to the water user having a contract for the stored water between the Bureau of Reclamation, or owners of the reservoir, and the water user.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.



When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, an in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction, and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 12, 2015, at Special Order Volume 96, Page 192, approving Transfer Application 11836, supersedes Certificate 80854, State record of Water Right Certificates.
