CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JUNE AND ALLEN KALKHOVEN and
DAN AND JANICE AAMODT
HALFWAY OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of HOLBROOK CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 20 ACRES, and DOMESTIC and STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 235. The date of priority is 1895.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre during August, and one-half acre-foot per acre during September, of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:



This certificate is issued to correctly describe the water right as ordered by the Order Amending Pine Creek Decree (Case No. 18CV53444) signed on March 19, 2019 by Judge Erin K. Landis of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The Order recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 19, at Page 358, and corrects the Decree to identify the source of water of a water right in the name of A. C. Brown and supersedes Certificate 10228.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This right is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
