confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK OF WALLOWA RIVER (LOSTINE RIVER),  
 TRIBUTARY TO WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 2.7 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK  
 USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County.  
 The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at  
 Page 181. The date of priority is 1891.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for  
 said purposes, and shall not exceed 1½ acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31<sup>st</sup>  
 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the  
 irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitation contained in said  
 decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition  
 for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and  
 OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition  
 for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the  
 petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Before water use may begin, the water user shall install and maintain at the River Pump Point of Diversion, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the River Pump point of diversion. If Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 16 2019, approving Transfer Application T-12994, and together with Certificate 94348, supersedes Certificate 3091, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
