confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-1645. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS, A TRIBUTARY OF DEEP CREEK (CLACKAMAS RIVER)

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 47.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.33 CFS FROM WELL 1 AND 0.27 CFS FROM WELL 2, NOT TO EXCEED 0.37 CFS IN ANY COMBINATION FROM THE TWO WELLS

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 20, 1960

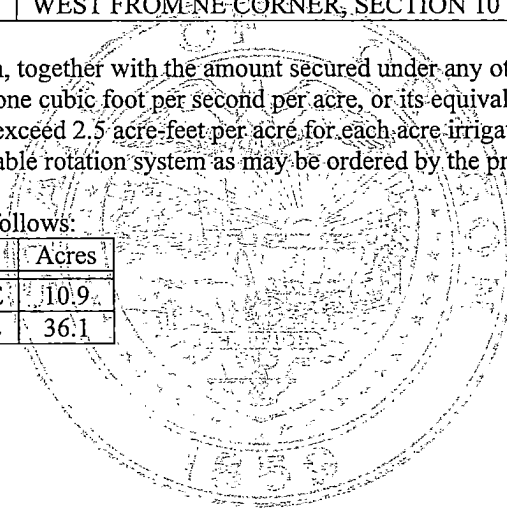
The wells are located as follows:

2 S	3 E	WM	10	NE NE	WELL 1 - 400 FEET SOUTH AND 613 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 10
2 S	3 E	WM	10	NE NE	WELL 2 - 448 FEET SOUTH AND 87 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
