confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498.

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 32.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.59 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE AUTHORIZED DIVERSION MEASURED AT THE HEAD OF THE DITCH OR AT THE POINT WHERE THE SAME LEAVES THE NATURAL STREAM, FROM APRIL 1ST TO OCTOBER 1ST OF EACH YEAR

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, at both the **ADDITIONAL** and **AUTHORIZED** points of diversion.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an **ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION** and **PLACE OF USE** approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 6, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 2113, approving Transfer Application 8719, and together with Certificate 79701, supercedes Certificate 17197, State record of Water Right Certificates.
