CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RONALD A. MOORE
901 NW CHADWICK LANE
MYRTLE CREEK, OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 40.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-12200. The date of priority is JUNE 1, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-ONE HUNDRED FIFTEENTH (1/115) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.74 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and an annual volume limitation of 69.8 Acre-Feet. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 75845, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 16 2019, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-109. This Certificate together with Certificate 94450, and the conserved water under CW-109, supersedes Certificate 75845.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
