CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER, for INSTREAM USE for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat, and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permits S-12200 and S-11867. The dates of priority are JUNE 1, 1936 and SEPTEMBER 18, 1935. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion below and further limited as follows:

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. Stream channel losses and gains calculated based on available data and the use of water by senior appropriators will determine the amount of water to which this right is entitled downstream from the original point of diversion within the specified stream reach.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW



Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificates 75845, 75846, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 113, Page 145, approving Conserved Water Application CW-109. This Certificate together Certificates 94448, 94449, and the applicant's portions of conserved water under CW-109 supersedes Certificates 75845 and 75846, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
