CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the FLAT CREEK BASIN for irrigation of 21.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under PermitG-4489. The date of priority is JANUARY 17, 1969 . The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

15 S	4 W	WM	30	NE SW	410 FEET SOUTH AND 790 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1/250 of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.83 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes water right Certificate 40768, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 16 2019, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-110. This Certificate together with the conserved water under CW-110 supersedes Certificate 40768.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
