CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-11432. The date of priority is OCTOBER 1, 1934. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
