CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the UMATILLA BASIN for IRRIGATION of 222.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10087. The date of priority is MARCH 28, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.36 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.


The works constructed shall include an airline or pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 83134, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered ~~JUL 22 2019~~, approving Transfer Application T-13113.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
