CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E. D. TIRRILL
PRINEVILLE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of the Main Channel of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of the irrigation of 132.2 acres of land.

This right was perfected under Permit S-823. The date of priority is AUGUST 24, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.65 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 2734, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 26 2019, approving Transfer Applications T-11347.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
