CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LES SCHWAB TIRE CENTERS OF OREGON, INC.
PO BOX 667

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 69.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-48863. The date of priority is JULY 15, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.28 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from Diversion #1 (North Fork), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 55659, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **DEC 18 2019**, approving Transfer Application T-12404.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
