 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 19.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5108. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


