CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF INDIAN CREEK for IRRIGATION of 5.75 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 5.15 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and that the total quantity diverted during the irrigation season shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to describe the right modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 08 2019, and recorded at Special Order Volume 113, Page ~~851~~ 852, approving a partial diminution of the right evidenced by Certificate 87439, State Record of Water Right Certificates. This certificate supersedes Certificate 87439.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitation contained in the decree.

The right to the use of water for the purposed aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
